

Clann Credo Cookie Policy – February 2021

1. Introduction

1. This Cookie Policy explains how Clann Credo CLG ("we", "us", "our" or "ourselves") uses cookies on our website. This Cookie Policy applies to everyone who visits our website, please read it carefully.

1.2. Www.clanncredo.ie is a site operated by Clann Credo CLG. We are a company limited by guarantee, registered in Dublin, Ireland, CRO No: 253147 and we are regulated by Charities Regulatory Authority: CRA No 20041076.

2. What is a Cookie?

2.1. Your internet browser has a feature called "Cookies" which store small amounts of data on your computer about your visit to a website and distinguishes you from other users of the website. They are widely used in order to make websites work more efficiently and to provide website owners with information about how the website is used. Cookies improve your browsing experience by: (a) remembering settings so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you visit a new page; (b) remembering information you have given (e.g. country of residence) so you do not have to keep re-entering it; and (c) measuring how you use the website so we can make sure it meets your needs.

2.2. The website uses 4 types of cookies:

(a) Strictly Necessary Cookies – these enable users to browse a website and allow the features of the website to work correctly such as navigating between pages of a website

(b) Preference Cookies - these enable the website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like the preferred language or the region that you are in

(c) Statistic Cookies – these help the website owners understand how visitors interact with the website by collecting and reporting information anonymously

(d) Marketing Cookies – these are used to track visitors. The intention is to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third party advertisers

3. How We Use Cookies

3.1. We do not collect any personal information about you from browsing our website. Cookies are used so that the website recognises you have accepted the disclaimer (which is a regulatory requirement) so it will not appear each time you navigate to a new page of the website. Cookies are also used to gather anonymous usage of pages via Google Analytics.

3.2. Google Analytics stores information about what pages you visit, how long you are on the website, how you got here and what you click on. We do not collect or store your personal information (e.g. your name or address) so this information cannot be used to identify who you are. We do not allow Google to use or share our analytics data.
