"to provide a state-of-the-art Integrated Rural Resource Centre to meet the needs of the local community providing a focal point in Virginia for social activities, fostering community involvement and inclusion while supporting the local rural sector." The idea for a rural resource centre starting in November 2006, following a public open space conference facilitated by Michael Kenny, Maynooth College.

Feasibility Study by MCA Consulting in 2008.

Applied for Planning Permission in 2011

Set up a sub committee, Virginia Show Centre Ltd to complete built.

Building started in 2013 and completed in 2014

Officially opened on 06.02.15 (2 years ago) by AN Taoiseach Enda Kenny.

COVERED EVENTS HALL (41m X 24m) suitable for Exhibitions, markets,

CAFÉ large lounge/dining area suitable for social gatherings and smaller events.

Universal access and toilet facilities for people with disabilities

Premises and equipment comply with current Health & Safety Regulations.

Lunch facilitates on site (Separate from the training facility), also Kitchen, Microwave, Fridge, Tea & coffee making facilities available.




