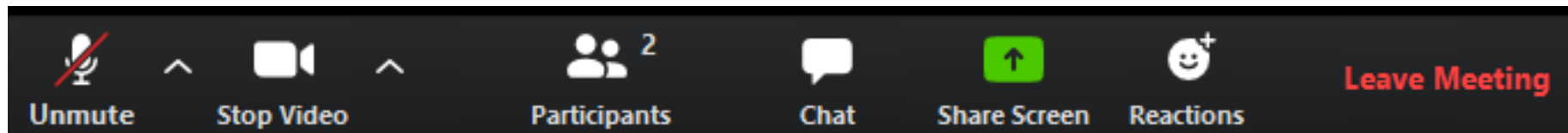
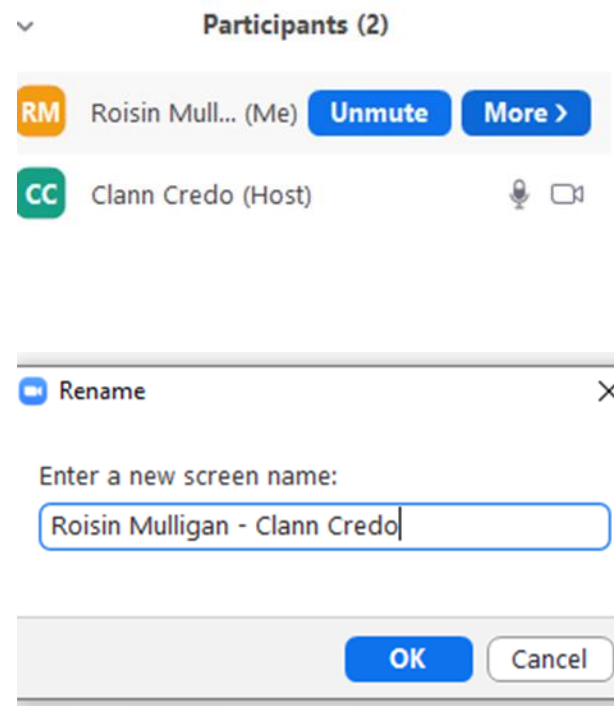

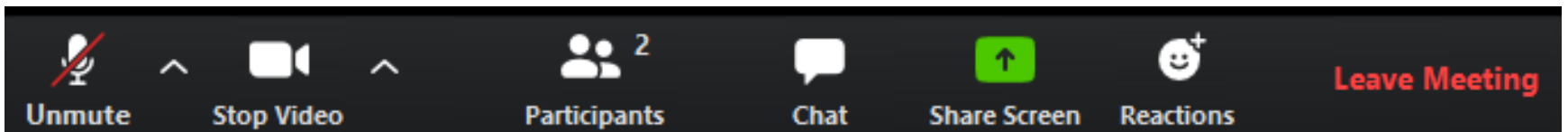

Community Space Opportunities?

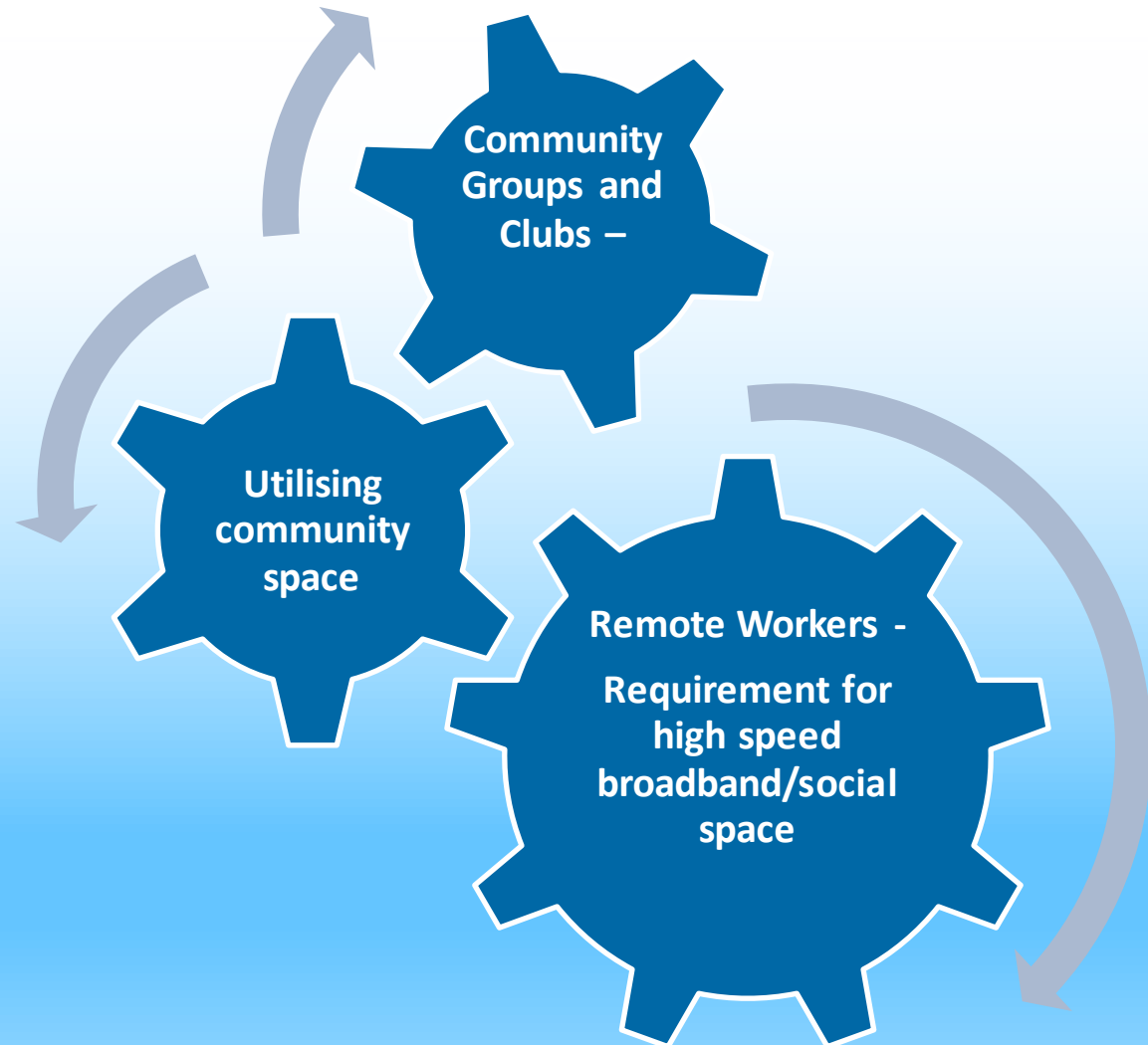
- **Rural Development Plan – Our Rural Future
